

Archer Design Principles

The Archer Complex is intended to function as a multi-use, campus environment that reflects the rural character of Laramie County. Infrastructure and buildings are to be designed to blend into the prairie landscape. Buildings will incorporate angled roofs, natural materials and sustainable design. Landscaping consists of native and adaptive species and designed for minimal water usage. The use of curb and gutter is discouraged. Storage and service areas will be screened from streets and adjacent uses. Screening and fencing consists of natural materials to the extent possible. Signage for county facilities shall be consistent throughout the Archer Complex.
