

OBLIGATIONS ASSUMED WHEN RESERVING CLEAR CREEK PARK AREA

1. The group and its members or guests must follow all the general rules of the park posted at the entrance and/or rules enclosed in the reservation confirmation.

*** PETS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES ***

*** FIREARMS & FIREWORKS ARE PROHIBITED IN AND AROUND PARK AREA***

2. The area reserved must be policed for litter; tables, grills and other barbecue pits must be left in suitable condition for others to use.
3. If upon arrival at the park, you find damaged equipment or trash build up, report it to the Laramie County Public Works Department, telephone 633-4302 (Mon.-Thurs.) Or Mr. Shad Yenglin at 630-4657 (Fri, Sat, Sun.).
4. If it is determined that your group is responsible for damage to park equipment and /or grounds, or if your group did not police the park properly, you will be required to reimburse the board for the costs incurred, including attorney fees and court costs. You will not be able to reserve facilities at the park in the future until a settlement has been reached.
5. The reservation group will be responsible to follow and uphold the Wyoming State Liquor Laws while in the park.
6. Vehicle access will be provided to the shelter area for vendor use (it is limited to loading/unloading of supplies) and to accommodate disability access requirements. Prior permission is necessary for the park manager to unlock and open the gate leading to the shelter area.
7. The Laramie County Recreation, Planning & Advisory Board and/or Park Manager, reserve to right to limit or stop vehicles from driving on the grass to load/unload at the shelter. Users will load/unload from the access road or main parking lot. (Driving on the grass after a heavy rain will leave ruts, damage sprinkler system, damages sod, or the vehicle may become stuck.) Please do not use the lawn area for parking. Any group failing to comply is subject to damage costs and restrictions as stated in item #4.
8. Park hours are from 8:00am to 8:00pm. The Park opens in May and closes in September.
9. In case of an emergency or if you have a problem at the park, please contact the Cheyenne Police Department or the Laramie County Sheriff's Department.
- 10. Please make sure all gates are closed and locked when leaving the park.**
